Function of the Part

Used for steering and turning.

Food and water enter the shark's body here.

Senses changes in water pressure, vibrations and movement in the water.

Gets oxygen from the water, and water exits the body from here.

Propels the shark forward.

Makes the shark stable and prevents it from rolling.

Senses electrical fields of other animals.

The shark may use these to examine an unfamiliar object.
