
The Weatherman

Will it be warm or very hot? Will the north wind blow hard or not?




The weather is an important thing. We need to know what it will bring.

Fishermen must know if it will storm. Farmers must know when it's too warm.




Weather is important, too, when we plan a barbecue. If there are rain clouds in the sky, you'll need to be where it is dry.




Long ago, if the skies looked black, Grandpa used the Farmer's Almanac,

To plant his corn and use the plow, but things are really different now.




Forecasters now use technology to study meteorology.

They also use their naked eye to watch conditions in the sky.




Weathermen use many tools. They also go to special schools.

Forecasters look at weather charts. That's sometimes where the forecast starts.




Weathermen use many things to predict what the weather brings.

We need to know for many reasons; the weather changes with the seasons.




Sometimes predictions can be wrong. Sometimes the wind is not as strong,
