
The Grasslands Biome






The word *climate* means the weather in a place the whole year 'round.

A biome is the climate and location where a community is found.



There are many types of biomes on the Earth that can be seen. One is called a grasslands biome where the grass is often green.

There are bobcats, prairie chickens, prairie dogs, and fireflies. When it's mealtime on the prairies, hawks and finches fill the skies.



In savannahs, or tropical grasslands, cheetahs and elephants are seen.

There are purple-crested louries and pigeons that are green.



Many acres of these grasslands we can see have disappeared. Some grasslands are now protected to keep more land from being cleared.
