how to assemble
nonsense word fluency fans
first, print out each page onto colorful cardstock.
-next, cut out each of the 50 fluency fan blades around each border.
-then, punch a small hole through the circle located at the bottom of each fluency fan blade.
-last, stack as many or as few fluency
fan blades together as you wish and hold together with a brass fastener. i like to make five different fans with ten blades in each but it is up to you and the individual needs of your students! a book ring can also be used.
