

DRIVER'S ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES

The North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles requires that individuals applying for a permit present a driver's eligibility certificate from his/her school. In order to obtain a certificate, the student must have passing grades in 70% or more of his or her classes. Adequate academic progress will be evaluated at the midpoint of the school year (first semester grades) and at the end of the school year. The student's parent or legal guardian must present the following documents to the principal or the Dean of Student Behavior in order to obtain the Driver's Eligibility Certificate:

- Student's birth certificate
- Student's social security card
- Proof that the student has passed driver's education
- Student's most recent semester or year-end report card
