

# WHAT ARE TEXT FEATURES?



**Text features are images, charts, fonts, or other graphics that help readers understand nonfiction text- like articles or text books.**

# PHOTOGRAPH CAPTION

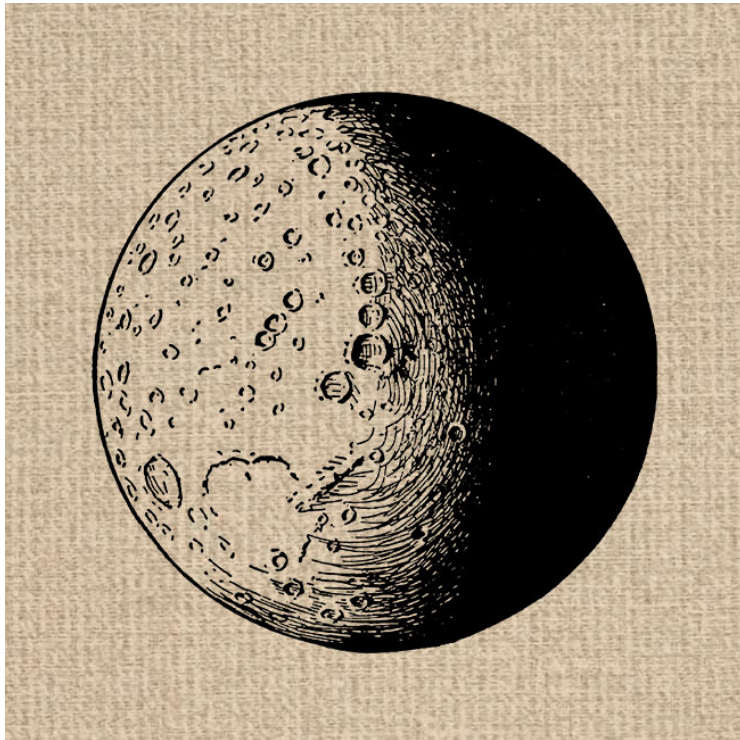


THIS IS A FULL MOON , WHICH OCCURS ABOUT ONCE A MONTH

**INFORMATION LOCATED DIRECTLY BENEATH, TO THE SIDE, OR ABOVE A PICTURE IS A CAPTION. IT HELPS READERS UNDERSTAND THE PICTURE.**

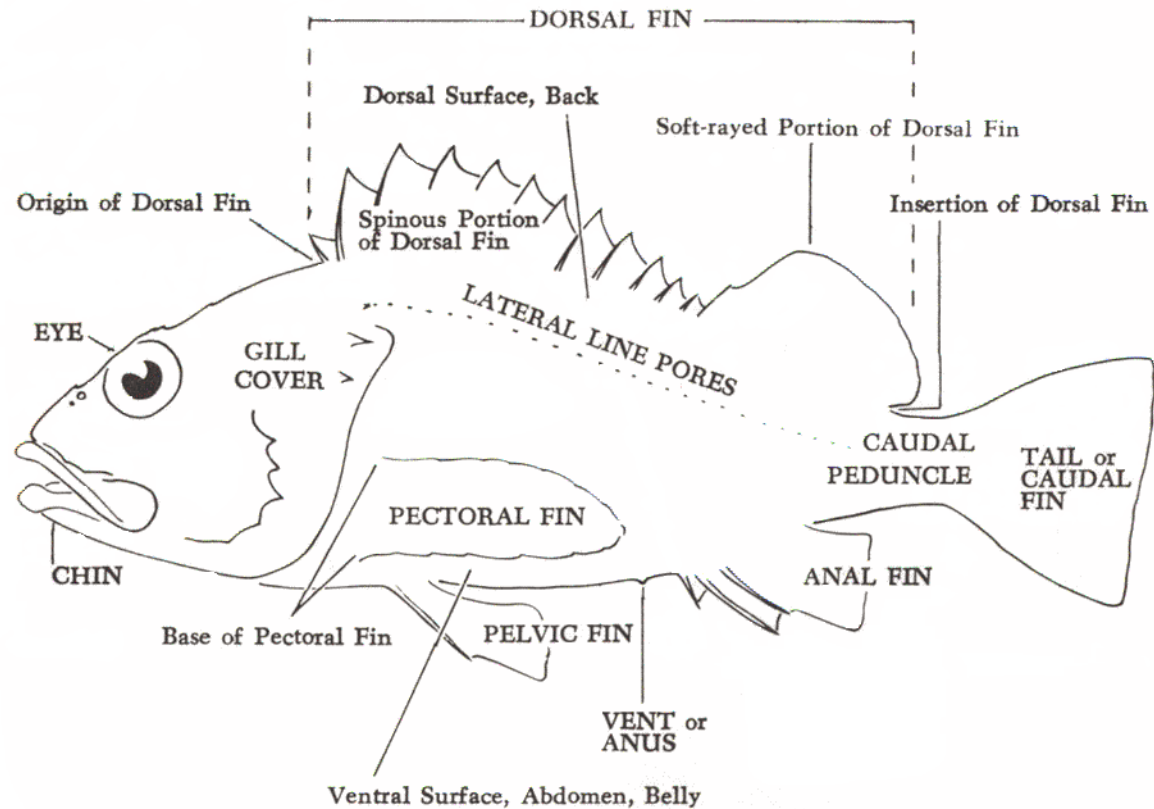

# FONT TYPES

**BOLD**- darker text so show emphasis or importance. Many times vocabulary words are put in **bold**.

*Italics*- slanted text to show emphasis. Sometimes authors put text in italics to show what the author or narrator is thinking at the time.

# TEXT BOX

A text box is a box out to the side of a paragraph that has important information. It can include vocabulary, important details, or fun facts. It is always important to read the text boxes.
